

Letter to Survivors - October 31st 1995

Date: October 31st, 1995

Dear Survivors,

With the power returned and a fresh shipment of gas I hope this finds you in high spirits! I wished to take a moment and update everyone on some matters that have been weighing on my mind and what the KSSA plans to do because of it.

1. ****The Requiem of the Returned**** - The Requiem has escalated more and more, from cutting down power poles, fully destroying the pump house at the water treatment plant, even an outright attack on Sanctuary itself after threatening all of us who are just trying to survive.

We are working with the surrounding factions to determine a base of operations, but the agents seem to be extremely elusive, since most have a large amount of zeds around them at any time allowing them plenty of time to escape.

Further, to strengthen our defenses against any further attacks to our area. I will be directly reaching out to St Memphis. Their offer to provide air support from the Air National Guard forces there has not been forgotten. We may need your help in the coming days to collect and prepare trade shipments for them to help bolster their opinion of us and accelerate any development they're still in the middle of. We will naturally reward those efforts to the best of our ability.

2. ****Infrastructure (Re)Development**** - We will be mounting missions soon to retake and rebuild the Rosewood Encampment and the Water Treatment Plant. Both of these locations we view as critical infrastructure and paramount to our mission and quality of life in the area.

3. ****From the scrap pile**** - We're glad to see so many of you using the metal casting manuscripts we found. We'll continue transcribing the weapons and armor blueprints we have into something readable for the average person, so look forward to that!
